# PART 2: BREASTFEEDING, LACTATION & FEEDING BABY

If you plan to breastfeed your newborn, it will be beneficial to practice setting up your home environment before baby's arrival. Breastfeeding in your house will be different than in a hospital bed. We will work together to prepare you for breastfeeding in your home. I cover over 30 topics related to breastfeeding, a few examples of the topics covered include:

- Infant feeding options
- Feeding frequency & duration
- Feeding cues
- Feeding on demand (versus on a schedule)
- Classifications of breast milk
- Hormones of lactation
- Establishing and maintaining breastmilk supply

- Proper positioning, latch and transfer of milk
